The North American composite panel industry has been very committed to emission reduction and compliance with established regulations. In fact, the industry as a whole worked for years with the State of California Air Resources Board (CARB) to create and implement one of the most stringent formaldehyde regulations in the world. Most recently, the industry has been at the forefront of effort to have these emission levels harmonized and federalized by the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) in order to promote a more level playing field for all composite panel manufacturers providing products to the US markets.

We want to assure you that all Arauco North America composite panel products are third party certified to the CPA 4-11 Eco-Certified Composites (ECC) Sustainability Standard and California Air Resources Board (CARB) Airborne Toxic Control Measure (ATCM) 93120 regulation, to the extent to which it applies to our products. As such, we comply with all applicable requirements of the ATCM regulation including quality assurance emissions testing, labelling, record keeping and applying statements of compliance to company invoices and bills of lading. This statement also applies to any products that Arauco imports from our South American mills.
